Detailed Design and Construction Supervision Firm for Kep Provincial Hospital, Ratanak Mondol Referral Hospital, Sambo Referral Hospital, and Srey Santhor Referral Hospital (CS01b)

The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) towards the cost of Cambodia Rapid Immunization Support and Resilient Health Infrastructure Project executed by the Ministry of Health

The Ministry of Health intends to apply a portion of the loan for engaging consultancy firms for Detailed Design and Construction Supervision services for the construction and renovation of health facilities under the project. The consulting firm is expected to mobilize in March 2027; The total person months (pm) input over the assignment for international experts is around 27 person-months and for national experts up to 632 person-months i.e., for a total estimated 659 person-months over a 48 months contract period.

The main objectives of the consultancy are the preparation of the detailed designs and provide the supervision over the construction works. The assignment includes 04 level CPA 1 and CPA 2 level healthcare facilities in Kep, Battambang, Kratie and Kampong Cham Provinces. The civil works is to be implemented over a period of 24 months. The (estimated) budget for the consultancy is \$3.69 million.

The Ministry of Health now invites interested and suitably qualified firms to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the said consultancy services. The selection will apply the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method described in the Procurement Policy and Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers and the User's Guide on the Selection of Consulting Service for ADB Borrowers, both which are published on ADB's website (<https://www.adb.org/documents/procurement-regulations-adb-borrowers> and <https://www.adb.org/sites/default/files/selection-consulting-services.pdf>).

Submission of EOI. This Request for EOI is published in local media as well on ADBs Consultancy Recruitment Notices (CSRN) website. Interested consultants are required to submit an EOI through ADBs Consultant Management System at cms.adb.org. The EOI template is available online at <https://www.adb.org/documents/recruitment-firms-individual-consultants-executing-agencies> under 'recruitment of firms'. The use of the standard form is mandatory to submit an EOI.

EOIs submitted outside this system, through email or hard-copy will not be accepted. The closing data for the submission of an EOI is on or before 11.59 pm (Manila) on **09 April 2026**.

Required qualifications. The firm must have at least 15 years of experience in building design, with proven technical expertise in the preparation of detailed design and construction supervision of building projects, specifically hospitals in Cambodia or in a similar context. In addition, the firm must be able to demonstrate having experience with similar projects in Cambodia and must be familiar with Cambodian construction law, building code, climate change resilient design standard, greenhouse building design, fire, electrical and mechanical codes in construction, as well as international environmental and social safeguards standards and procurement tendering documents as issued by the Ministry of Economy and Finance for national contracting of works.
